RADIO DRAMA PODCASTS

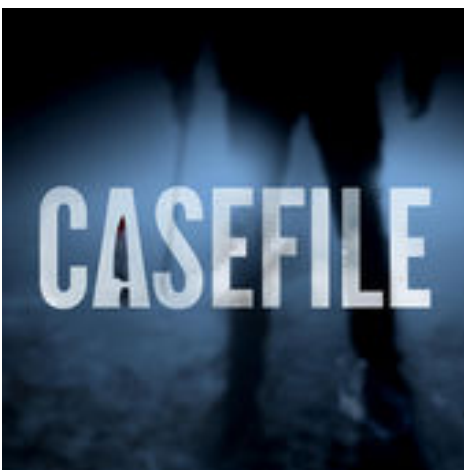

It takes a look at what happens in the average American courthouse and the cases that come through their door.

Like Serial, Casefile takes a closer look at true crimes that have taken part in Australia analyzing where evidence and lawyers could've convicted the wrong person. The podcast is, and each episode completes one story, unlike Serial where they use the entire season to explore one theme. Each episode can last from 20 minutes to an hour and a half and looks at the murder or abduction through the criminal's trial and sometimes discussing potential theories if the perpetrator was never caught.
